

ARTICLE 21

Right-of-Way

Section 1. Right-of-Way From Member. The members of the Cooperative shall, without charge to the Cooperative, grant any easement, or any other rights, privileges or licenses over any property owned by them for the distribution lines of the Cooperative, or for any other purpose necessary and proper to the conduct of the Cooperative's business, when requested.

Section 2. Delays. The Cooperative will not construct an electric line for any application for electric service until such time all right-of-way is acceptable to the Cooperative.

Section 3. Tree Clearance. It will be the responsibility of the applicant for electric service on all new construction to clear all of his proposed right-of-way and the applicant or member shall without charge to the Cooperative grant permission to spray, cut or trim all trees and shrubbery to the extent necessary, to cut down from time to time all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees that are tall enough to strike the wires in falling.
